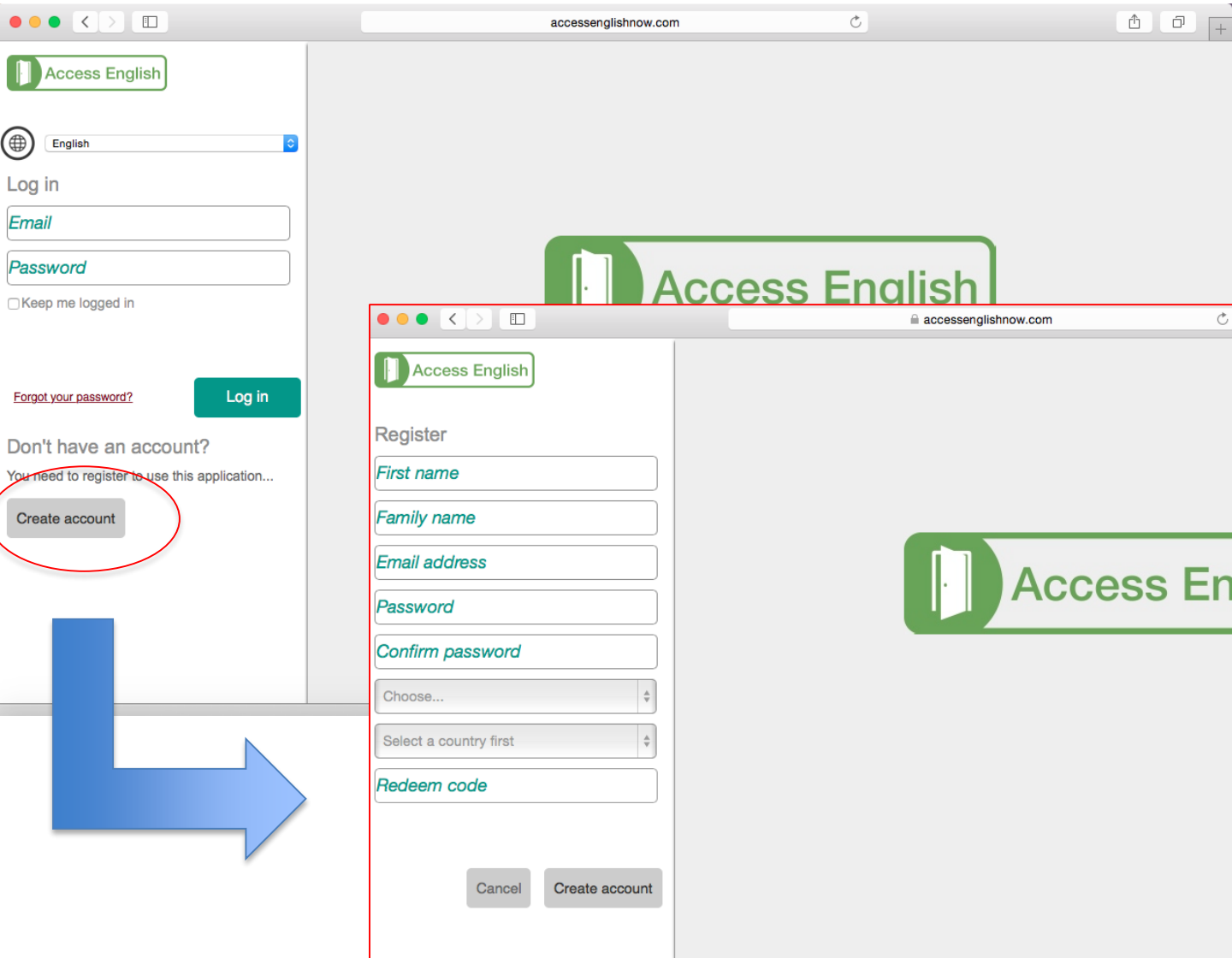
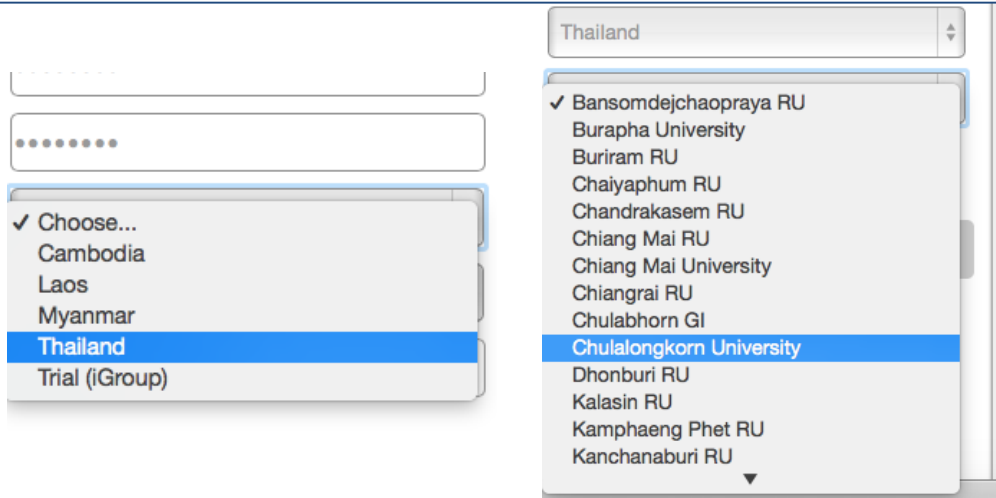

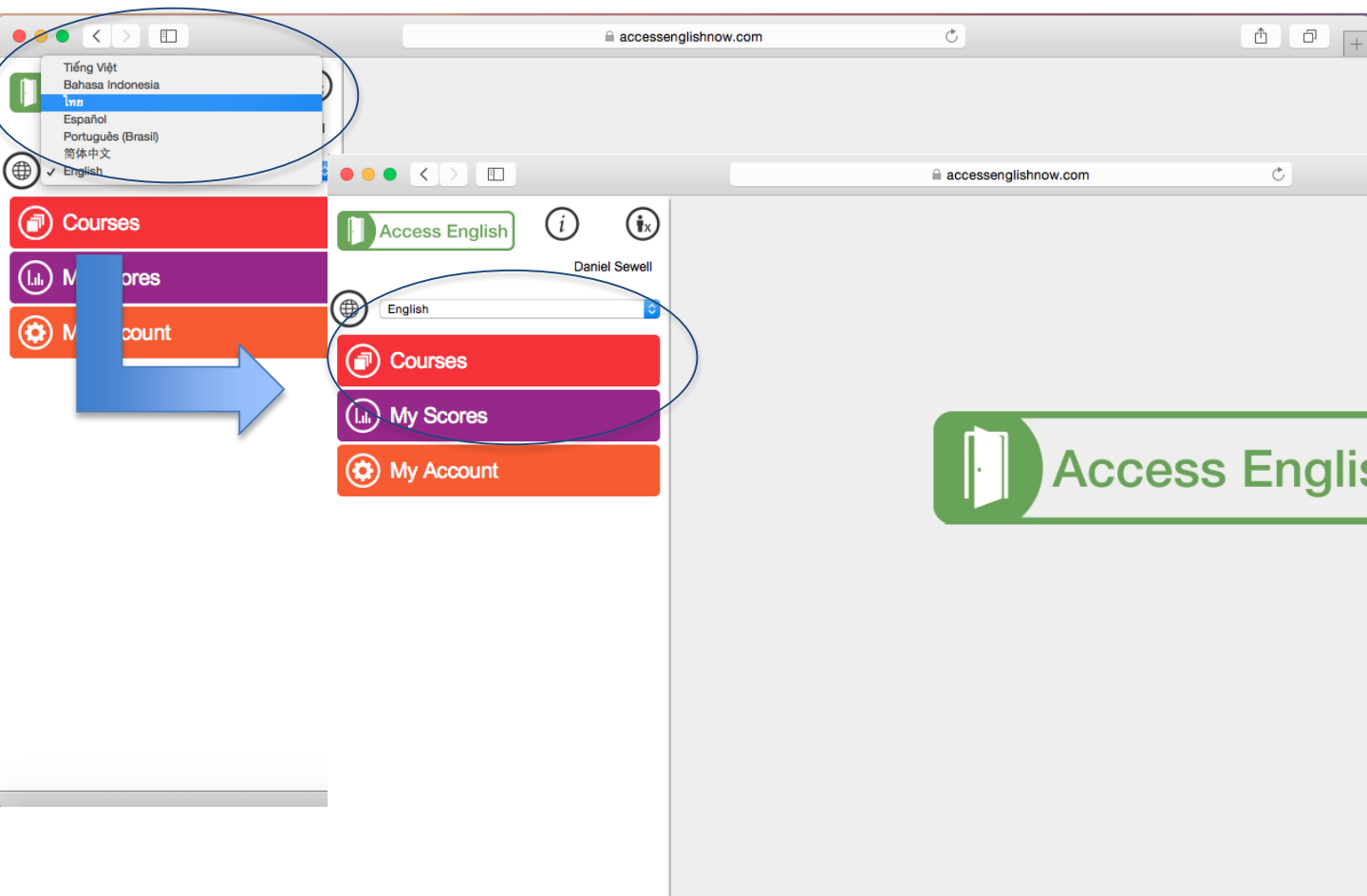
Create your account at the Login Homepage:



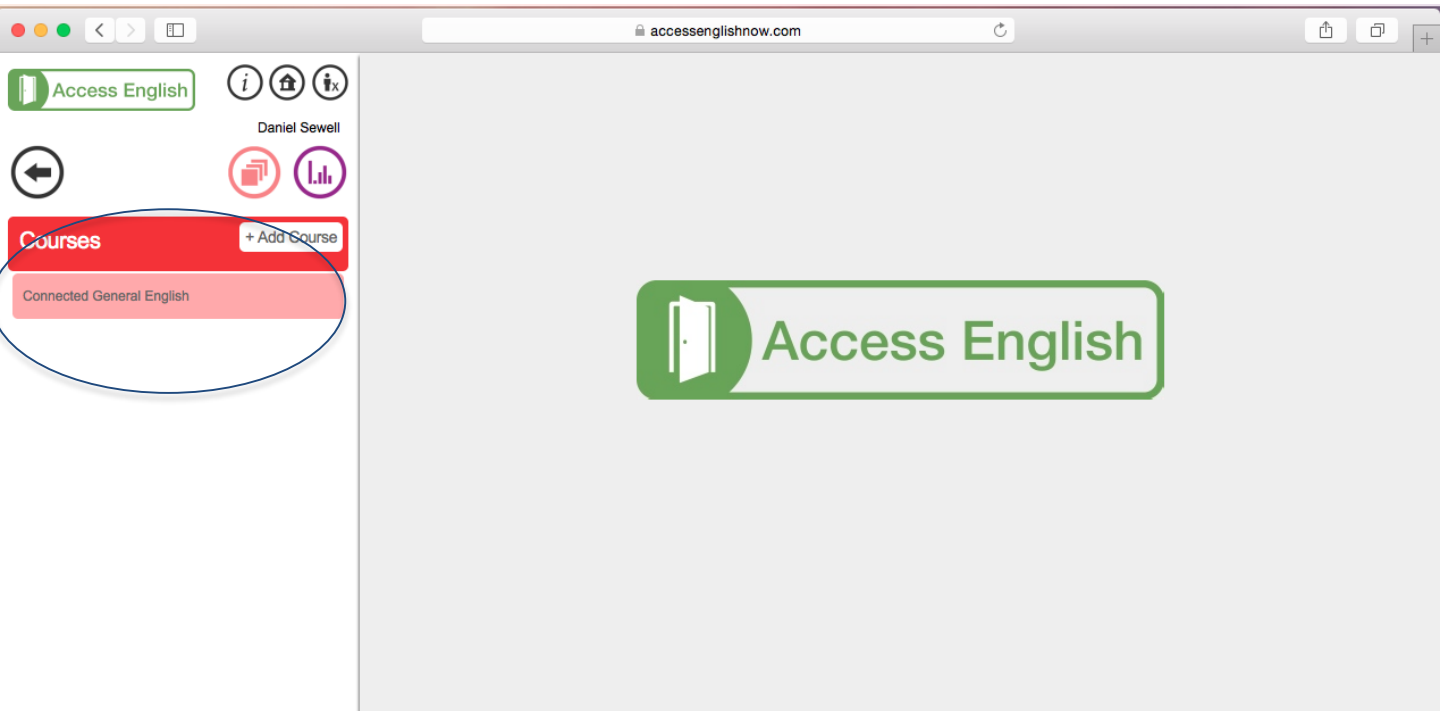
Choose your Country and Affiliation from the list boxes:
