Bone marrow stem cells, for example, are the most primitive cells in the marrow. From them all the various types of blood cells are descended. Bone marrow **stem cell** transfusions (or transplants) were originally given to replace various types of blood cells.

HUNGARY



The Hungarian Republic is a landlocked country in central Europe. The land is mostly low-lying and drained by two rivers, the Danube (Duna) and its tributary, the Tisza. The main highlands, rising to a maximum height of 1,015 m [3,330 ft], are in the north-east. But most of the land east of the Danube belongs to a region called the Great Plain (Nagyalföld), which covers about half of Hungary.

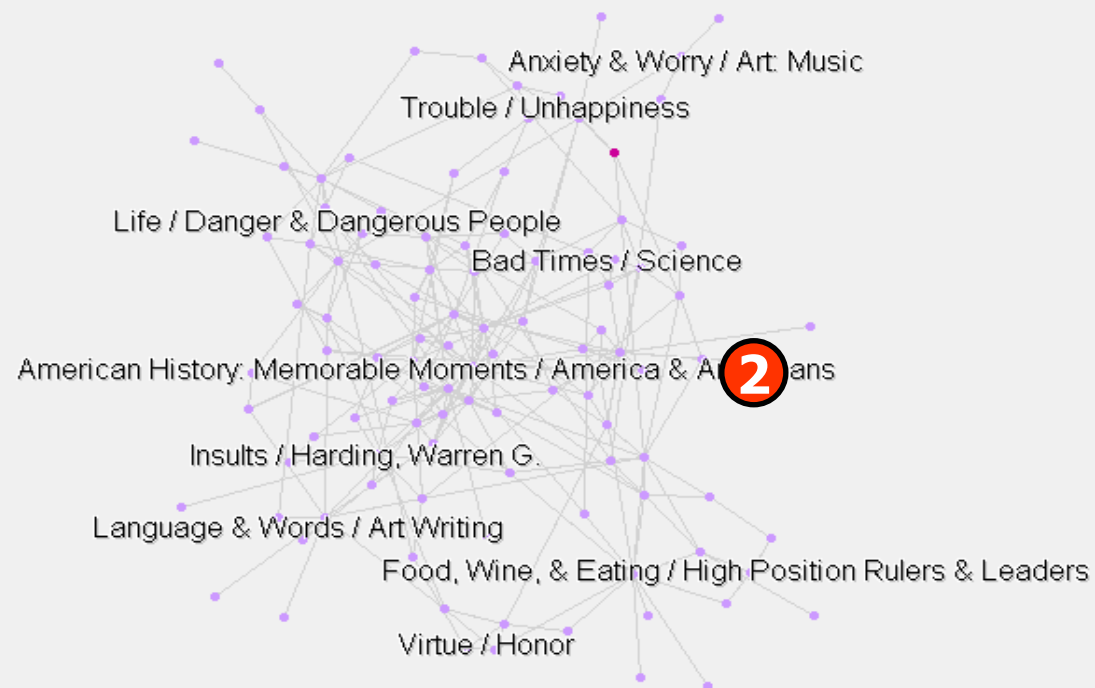
