Digital initiatives and metadata use in Thailand

Abstract

Purpose — This paper aims to provide information about various digital initiatives in libraries in Thailand and especially use of Dublin Core metadata in cataloguing digitized objects in academic and government digital databases.

government digital databases.

Design/methodology/approach — The author began researching metadata use in Thailand in 2003 and 2004 while on sabbatical from the University of Vermont. A small number of government librarions.

were in the process of building up their digital databases. These were identified from a survey conducted by the author at that time. The author continues to monitor the development of digital initiative and has identified several new digital initiatives created by academic institutions since then. The digital initiatives operated by Thai government agencies and academic institutions that existed in 200 presented, along with one example of a metadata record randomly selected from each of these projects. These examples illustrate Dublin Core metadata use and cataloguing practice employed in the

digital databases. The author's current research on the development of digital initiatives is included.
Findings — This paper presents what the author feels are some significant technical and legal issues facing Thai digital initiatives. A major copyright issue in Thailand, the ineffective enforcement of

Findings — This paper presents what the author feels are some significant technical and legal issues facing Thai digital initiatives. A major copyright issue in Thailand, the ineffective enforcement of intellectual property laws relating to access rights, is presented. Also discussed is the significant obstacle to record retrieval created by the structure and complexity of the Thai language.

Originality/value — This paper identifies important issues and problems related to Thai digital initiatives and offers suggestions and comments aimed at enhancing the development and progress of digital initiatives.



This database is developed and maintained by TIAC, which operates under the Minister of Science and Technology. The database consists of theses and dissertations from 38 public and private universities, colleges and higher education institutes in Thailand. The TIAC, 2006 Annual Report shows a steady increase in the number of Thai theses and dissertations in this database during the per from 2003 to 2006: 53,152 in 2003, 60,713 in 2004, 70,043 in 2005, and 76,697 in 2006. At the time of writing (November 2007) approximately 90,000 theses and dissertations are now available to the public. This fee-based database is a useful resource and is heavily used by researchers, faculty members and students from the graduate schools of several universities. However the holdings information incomplete and varies from one institution to the other. The majority of materials in this collection are in the Thai language with some abstracts in English. Access to this collection is by institute, major (degree), author, title, advisor, and keyword (descriptor) as can be seen in Figure 1.

3.2 Thai Digital Collection (TDC) – ThaiLIS database

collection is available in full text to consortium members only. Currently 79 universities, colleges and higher education institutes in Thailand participate in this consortium. The Dublin Core metadata re created by each participant and a variety of subject headings are used, such as Library of Congress Subject Headings (LCSH), Thai Subject Headings (ThaSH), and keywords. Some records also included by each participant and a variety of subject headings are used, such as Library of Congress Classification (LCC) in the source metadata element. Examples of three records from this database can be seen in Figures 2-4.

The TDC is an integral part of the ThaiLIS (Thai Library Integrated System Consortium). It consists of articles, research reports, theses and dissertations, images, archives and rare books. This digital

3.3 iKnowledge Digital contents management system (DCMS) – Chulalongkorn University Intellectual Repository (CUIR)


This digital collection consists of e-theses and e-research reports from Chulalongkorn University, developed by the Central Library of the Center of Academic Resources. The Chulalongkorn University Academic Resources Center has adapted Dublin Core metadata and this is also now being used to create the iKnowledge and Digital Contents Management System (DCMS). This database is incorporate in the ThaiLIS, a project operated by the University Library Network, started in 2002 (Siripan, 2005). The Dublin Core metadata elements used for describing digitized materials in this collection are vere detailed. For example, metadata records for theses/dissertations include abstracts and are often in both Thai and English languages. Title and the title alternative elements represent title in English and Thai or vice versa. Library of Congress subject headings (LCSH) and Thai subject headings (ThaSH) are included in the thesis and research report metadata records, including call numbers (Library of Congress Classification (LCC) and local Thai call numbers). This collection can be searched by keyword, title, creator, subject, degree disciplines, type, and full text (members only). Examples of two records from the database are shown in Figures 5 and 6.


3.4 Thai research databases


This is a collection of databases, which consist of research projects, reports, grants on science, technology and energy information from the Thailand Research Fund (TRF), the Health Systems Research Institute (HSRI), the National Science and Technology Development Agency (NSTDA), and the departments under the NSTDA, the National Center for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology (BIOTE the National Metal and Materials Technology Center (METC), the National Electronics and Computer Technology Center (NECTEC), and the Technology Management Center (TMC). The information these databases is mainly in the Thai language with some abstracts in English. The Dublin Core metadata elements (DCMES) were adapted to describe these documents and the template was created TIAC.


Eight elements of Dublin Core metadata were adapted and are used: title, researcher, institution, source of funds, status (completed or ongoing), coverage, date completed, and abstracts (some of the metadata records have abstracts and some do not). These collections are available for the public and the information can be searched by either keyword or Boolean search — by types of documents (sucresearch projects, grants), institutes (currently eight government agencies are represented), researchers, title, and year. An example of a record from the database can be seen in Figure 7.

Managing international business communication problems at work: a pilot study in foreign companies in Thailand

Abstract

Purpose - To provide information regarding international/intercultural communication problems, along with management tactics for coping and handling such problems occurring in the international business work setting in foreign companies operating in Thailand.

Design/methodology/approach - Exclusive 14 in-depth interviews with expatriate executives and Thai senior employees were conducted in four Japanese, two German, and two multinational compan Thailand. Both expatriates and Thai employees were asked to identify communication problems and describe how they managed such problems with international/intercultural partners, supervisors, or subordinates.

Research limitations/implications - The sample was quite small. The subjects reacted to the interview protocol based upon their own personal experience working in eight foreign companies in Thail which might not represent the entire intercultural/international viewpoints.
