The database provides access to full text articles published from 1879 to present.

How to begin SAGE Journals Online

From the main page of SAGE Journals Online, user can

1 Browse, and

2 Formulate Simple and Advanced Search.

Browse



Browse by **1** title, user will have alphabetical list of journal titles to choose and view in detail; browse by **2** discipline, user selects from four primary topics and their corresponding disciplines.

Advanced Search

Advanced search menu is already prompt with the database main page.

Advanced search steps are: ① Type word or phrase, ② Use Operator AND, OR, NO to limit or expand search, ③ identify Filed for search, ④ Search within SAGE journal available or others, ⑤ Limit date range, and ⑥ Format results, and ⑦ Click on "Search".

Figure above shows sample Advanced search for "*marketing*" AND "*brand loyalty*" within SAGE journals available and published from January 1847 to December 2012.

SAGE Journals Online enables user to **1** browse by Journal title, and **2** by Journal tile.

Search Results

The database provides different options for user to manage search results both from **①** Browse by Discipline or Title, and **②** Simple or Advanced search.

Results from Browse

Select journal *"Marketing Theory"* from Browse by title as the following.



The result screen will show O journal information and Impact Factor & Ranked, O Issues, O Most cited and Most read articles, and O "Search this journal" box to continue searching within this journal.

Simple/Advanced Search Results

User can work search results as many options as needed. The search results for *"marketing"* and *"brand loyalty"* will display different options as the following.



① Read Abstract, Full Text PDF, or References, ② Modify search, ③ Mark citations, and ④ Download checked citations to Citation Manager, for example EndNote.

When user chooses an article, more related information and other options will be available, for example, user can view "Articles citing this article" as the following.



Export

User can also click on \checkmark "Download to Citation Manager", namely to EndNote. The next screen will be displayed as the following figure.



On the right of the screen will provide citation manager formats. Seelct "EndNote", and click "Open" on the next screen. The selected citation(s) will be directly exported to EndNote as the following.

Click on X at the top blue bar to exit SAGE Journals Online.
