

How to begin Wiley Online Library



At URL <http://www.car.chula.ac.th/ref-db/slist.html#general>, select **Wiley Online Library**, the database home page will be displayed as the following.




From the main page of Wiley Online Library, user can:
 ❶ Browse, ❷ Search, and ❸ Advanced search.

Browse


“Browse” publications is available at the main page, see figure above, from which user can ❶ click on “Publications” for browse by Title A-Z, or ❷ click “Browse by Subject”, the next screen will be as one of the followings.



Publications A-Z covers journals, books, book series, lab protocols, and databases as displayed on the right; user can filter publication type as needed.



For “Browse by Subject”, user can select any subject from list, i.e. “Art & Applied Arts”, a popup menu of subject areas will be displayed for further selection as the following.




Search

Search option provides simple “Search box” for user to type word or phrase, i.e., search “All contents” for “Einstein, Albert”, and click  as below figure.




Search results screen for “Einstein, Albert” will be displayed as the next figure.



Advanced Search

Advanced Search offers more detailed searching, such as limiting it to a certain field, as well as giving the option to set a particular date range and incorporate Boolean operators (AND/OR/NOT) into desired search. Click “Advanced search” on the main page, user will get the following screen on next page.



The user then can formulate search by the following steps:

1 Type word or phrase in search box, i.e. to search in “All fields” for “world economy”, 2 specify “Date range” to “In the last 6 Months”, and 3 click on “Search”. The results screen will be available as the following.




Search Results


User can manage search results with the following options 1 Filter results by Publication type, 2 View Abstract, 3 Download full text PDF or HTML, 4 Click on any title to view in detail, 5 Choose item with the check box, and 6 Export Citation as next figure.

Export to EndNote

From the search result screen, user can continue to export citations to EndNote. To export, user can 1 Use the check box to select required items, 2 Click on “Export Citation”, 3 Select format as “EndNote” and choose “Export type” as either “Citation” or “Citation & Abstract”, click “Submit”, and 4 Click “Open”.



All selected citations will be directly exported to EndNote program as the following.
